Hostaria Romana \$\$

Authentic home-style Roman restaurant

Via del Boccaccio 1 (Via Rasella)

Great food and great service. Affordable, fresh & delicious Italian restaurant. For some people the best restaurant in Rome (from Tripadvisor)

Restaurant Gioia Mia Pisciapiano \$\$

Ristorante Trattoria (only 2 minutes from the apartment, accross the street)

Via degli Avignonesi 34

Tel. +39-064882784

Family owned Ristorante with excellent home-style food and a mixed crowd of tourists and locals. Nice atomsphere.

Restaurant Colline Emiliane \$\$

Via degli Avignonesi 22 (only 2 minutes from the apartment, accross the street)

A very good family restaurant with dishes from nord of Italy (Emilia), small but intimate.

Pizzeria / Restaurant Terrazza Barberini \$\$

Via Barberini, 16/A - Good neapolitan cuisine, located on a terrace overlooking the piazza.

Ristorante Hotel Bernini Bristol Roof Garden L'Olimpo \$\$\$

Piazza Barberini 23

From the spectacular terrace "L'Olimpo" of this 5 star hotel in Rome, you can dominate the view of the city, while tasting Mediterranean cuisine with a wide selection of the finest wines.

Il Gelato di San Crispino

Via della panetteria 42, near the Trevi Fountain

Il Gelato di San Crispino serves what many consider to be the best ice-cream in Rome - some say in the world.

The secret is the makers' obsessive control over the whole process. The flavours on offer change according to what's in season - in summer the lampone (raspberry) and susine (yellow plum) are fabulous. Cones would interfere with the purity of the product: only tubs are allowed.

And don't miss the Cappuccini Crypt:

At the corner of the Via Veneto and the Piazza Barberini, the Santa Maria della Concezione Church is mostly known for the Crypt of the Cappuccini Monks

About halfway up the stairs to the church, on the right side, you will find the entrance to the ossuary, known as the Capuchin Crypt, in which is displayed the bones of over 4000 Capuchin friars, collected between the years of 1528 and 1870. When one of the friars die, he is buried in a vault, and after some time the bones are retrieved and placed in this ossuary. The bones are fashioned into decorative displays in the Baroque and Rococo style.

Other restaurant bars ecc.. located in the center city

Gelateria at Giolitti

Via Uffici del Vicario,40 (near piazza Colonna)

It is the oldest gelateria in Rome. For me one of the best ice cream in Rome!

Pizzeria / Restaurant la Montecarlo \$

(near Piazza Navona)

Vicolo Savelli, 13

Simple and good roman dishes and good pizza also.

Pizzeria Baffetto (one of the best pizza in Rome) \$

Via del Governo Vecchio, 114

This tiny restaurnt is declared the best pizza in Rome by all the guidebooks and Gormet magazine.

The place is TINY - worth a little wait.

Pizzeria / Restaurant Da Francesco \$\$

Piazza del Fico (close to Piazza Navona). Simple and good roman dishes and good pizza also.

Restaurant Gusto \$\$\$

Piazza Augusta Imperatore,9 (near Via del Corso and the Spanish Steps). A restaurant, pizzeria, wine bar and bookshop. It's been around a few years now, but Gusto is still a modish spot for Sunday brunch as well as serving good dinners and pizzas. Outdoor tables are atmospherically located, opposite the Mausoleum of Augustus.

Margutta Vegetarian Restaurant \$\$\$

Pzza Rondamini, 53, - end of via Margutta near piazza del popolo)

30 - 60 Euro

The main meeting point for vegetarians in Rome, situated on the corner of the fascinating Via Margutta. Its menu boasts creative and witty dishes, realized by putting together an almost infinite series of combinations that the Mediterranean vegetable garden possesses.

Pizzeria / Restaurant Pan'Unto \$

Piazza Santa Rufina (Via della Lungaretta) Trastevere

is offering 5 Euro pizzas for lunch and dinner (Except Saturday nights). The pizzeria is not pretty, it's not trendy or elegant, but service is prompt and courteous. Pizzas are made in a wood-burning oven and can be prepared any way you like.

Go for lunch and order the special: tomato bruschetta, margherita pizza, water or beer, and a coffee for 7 Euros! Desserts are strictly homemade.

Restaurant Der Pallaro \$

Largo der Pallaro, 15 (near campo dei fiori)

Traditional, simple roman home cooking. They bring your meal to your table themselves, there's not menu. As well as the classic antipasti, there is carbonara, amatriciana, 'Pappardelle al pomodoro', 'Scaloppine', 'Straccetti', vegetables, cheeses and desserts. Fixed price menu (around 21 euro)

Wine-bar Palatium \$\$\$

Regional wine bar Via Frattina, 94, (wines from Lazio)

Specializes in showcasing the products of Lazio, including wines, olive oils, cheeses, cured meats. The simple modern decor, with polished wooden tables, makes a nice atmosphere in which to enjoy a glass of wine a while sampling traditional local dishes.

Restaurant / wine-bar Enoteca Cavour 313 \$\$

V. Cavour 31. Close to the Colosseum; (06-678-5496).

This wine bar (also restaurant) is nicely furnished in oak with wine bottles displayed on the rafters high above the drinkers' heads. The wine menu consists of twenty pages of wines from all of Italy's regions that range from €12 and up a bottle. There is also a menu of cheeses and meats from the many different regione.

Restaurant lo Zodiaco \$\$\$

Take cab and make sure to have booked in advance.

This is the restaurant with the best view in Rome, Not centrally located, but it is worth going just for the views over the city, that can be enjoyed from the delightful outside terrace or from inside the modern restaurant.
